Dear Judge Schneier,

Thank you for your decision of 21 March 2006. While I differ in my opinion with the reasoning in your decision -- that the AIV law means contact information and that I was operating an AIV, although unknowingly -- I appreciate your decision to grant me the AIV license and your recommendation to reinstate my real estate broker's license. I hope to get back to the business of providing useful real estate consumer and broker services.

In your decision, you mention that my real estate broker's license Hearing is scheduled for June 2006. To date, I have received no notice about this Hearing.
