Applicant, Ms. La La Wang, represented herself.

Objector, the Division of Licensing Services, was represented by Mr. Richard Drew, License Investigator III.


By application dated August 24, 2003, Ms. Wang applied for an apartment information vendor license. The Division of Licensing Services proposed to deny the application alleging that Ms. Wang lacks the good character and trustworthiness required for licensure.

Under the provisions of General Business Law, §416-f, State Administrative Procedure Act, Article 3, and 19 New York Codes, Rules and Regulations, Part 400, Ms. Wang requested a quasi-judicial, administrative hearing to review the Division of Licensing Services' proposed denial of her application for licensure as an apartment information vendor.

Ms. La La Wang proved by substantial evidence that she possesses the good character and trustworthiness required for licensure as an apartment information vendor.

I ORDER the application of Ms. La La Wang for a license as an apartment information vendor is granted.
