The previous denial letter dated March 16, 2004 contained a typographical error, please disregard said letter and replace with this corrected letter.

The Department of State proposes to deny your application for licensure as an Apartment Information Vendor for the following reason(s):

1. ***You have not proven, subsequent to Department of State, Division of Licensing Services administrative hearing determination (23 DOS 00) dated January 31, 2000, that you have fully complied with Judge Schneier's order set forth therein.***
2. ***Pursuant to an investigation conducted by the Department of State, Division of Licensing Services (Case #2003-2838), it was determined that applicant continues to engage in the business of apartment information vendor without benefit of a license; thereby indicating a lack of good character and trustworthiness required for licensure.***

Please be advised that we recognize your right to appeal this decision and to have an administrative law judge make a determination as to applicant's suitability or eligibility for licensure.
