To whom it may concern,

I am delighted to inform you that Judge Roger Schneier has resolved my outstanding licensing issues. After taking all facts into consideration, this week, on 21 March 2006, Judge Schneier, the same judge who suspended my real estate broker's license in 2000, made a finding that I was "trustworthy" and (a) granted me the AIV license and (b) recommended to NYDOS that they withdraw its proposed denial (per Janine Barnhart's letter dated 9 January 2006) and reinstate my real estate broker's license. Wrote Schneier:

"WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED THAT the application of LaLa Wang for a license as an apartment information vendor on behalf of Principal Connections Limited, UID #50PR0300477, is granted."

With respect to my application for reinstatement for a real estate broker's license, Judge Schneier wrote:

"Having received a hearing referral from the Division of Licensing Services the Tribunal is aware that the applicant has applied for the reinstatement of her license as a real estate broker which was suspended as a result of 1999 hearing. That hearing has been calendared for June 1, 2006.

The hearing has been requested because of the Division of Licensing Service's proposed denial of the application on the grounds that the applicant has failed to prove that she is no longer engaged in the business of apartment information vendor. Considering the instant decision, that reason is moot. It is suggested, therefore, that the complainant may wish to reconsider its position in that matter and grant the application for reinstatement of the applicant."

I would appreciate the prompt reinstatement of my real estate broker's license. Thank you for your attention.
