Dear Judge Schneier,

My attorney Nick Fortuna of Allyn & Fortuna, who represented me in the matter of my Apartment Information Vendor licensing issue, was informed by Whitney Clark of the New York Department of State that they are going to ask for an adjournment of the hearing for reinstatement of my real estate broker's license.

I request that NYDOS' adjournment request not be granted. Judge Neals found me "trustworthy." Your decision of 21 March 2006 found me "trustworthy" with no evidence of consumer complaints and points out that this hearing is moot. Other than selective enforcement, there is no viable reason to deny me the broker's license. A delay in the hearing will only serve to prejudice me in further denying me my rights and preventing me from pursuing my profession. I would like to put this matter behind me and move on. Since it is clear the Department will not be able to sustain a case against me, the matter should not be further delayed.

I request that either the hearing be held as scheduled on 1 June 2006 or that you issue a decision without the hearing that NYDOS reinstate my real estate broker's license.
